Sketch Released on Home Invasion in Destrehan

On January 3, 2011, at approximately 1000 hours, a black, male, subject knocked on the back door of a residence on Murray Hill Dr., in Destrehan. The subject told the female homeowner that she needed to come outside, that there was something behind her car. The female then exited her residence and immediately upon stepping outside, the male grabbed her by the hair, produced a handgun and forced her back into the residence. The subject then inquired as to whether there was anyone else in the residence and as to where a safe and any valuables were.

The subject then forced the female at gunpoint to a bedroom where the homeowner's daughter was and again demanded valuables. Two other black male subjects also armed then assisted in ransacking the residence. The subjects then duct taped the Victim's hands behind their backs.

During the robbery several items were taken such as: cell phones, televisions, cash, home telephones, and jewelry. The suspects then fled the residence.

Through the investigation St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office Detectives have identified that a witness observed a suspicious, small, four-door, faded grey in color car, occupied by one black male in the area, during the time frame of the incident. A witness has also been able to provide a sketch of one of the perpetrators.

Sheriff Champagne is asking for anyone with any information regarding this case or who can identify the subject in this sketch to please contact Detective Erik Brass at 985-783-1135 during normal business hours or 985-783-6807, which is 24 hour number. Citizens may also contact Crime Stoppers at 1-877-903-STOP. Citizens do not have to give their name nor testify and could receive up to a \$2500 reward.
