PERSON OF INTEREST

On September 24, 2014, an 82 year-old Destrehan woman received a knock on her door by two unknown black females claiming to deliver medical supplies. When the elderly woman stated that she did not order any supplies the two suspects asked to use a telephone book inside of the residence to get the correct address of where the supplies needed to be delivered. The victim allowed the two females inside her residence and went into another room to retrieve the phone book. After looking through the phone book the two females left without further incident.

A couple of hours later the victim was notified that someone had used her credit card. She then checked her purse and realized her checkbook and credit cards were stolen. Purchases were made in LaPlace, Covington, and New Orleans.

Last Friday, the Sheriff's Office sent out a release with a picture of a person of interest in this case. With the help of the public, The St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office was able to identify the woman as Alisha Howard of New Orleans.
