St. Charles Louisiana - Chief Joseph Cardella and Captain Donnie Smith attended the first National Sheriffs' Association Homeland Security Leadership Academy hosted by the Federal Law Enforcement Training Centers (FLETC) in Glynnco, Georgia from September 14-24, 2015. This initiative was developed by the National Sheriff's Association in collaboration with the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center.

Chief Cardella and Captain Smith experienced the first of its kind training that explored the contemporary issues impacting the law enforcement profession.
