Sheriff Champagne reports that on March 28, 2019, shortly after 7:20 p.m., deputies of the St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office responded to an armed robbery that occurred at the Dollar General located at 12309 Highway 90 in Luling, Louisiana.

During the investigation, it was learned that a black male subject clad in black clothing and sunglasses entered the Dollar General Store and brandished a handgun. The suspect demanded the register to be opened, but the employee was unable to open the register. The suspect then grabbed cigarettes and fled from the store.

A short time later, detectives learned that Jefferson Parish Sheriff's Office had arrested a subject that was believed to have involvement in the armed robbery at the Luling Dollar General Store. Detectives, working in partnership with Jefferson Parish Sheriff's Office, were able to identify the apprehended subject as Larry Davis, a 50 year old resident of New Orleans.

Larry Davis is currently incarcerated in the Jefferson Parish Correctional Center, pending criminal charges in Jefferson Parish. An arrest warrant will be secured for the arrest of Larry Davis in St. Charles Parish, which will be fulfilled upon his release from the Jefferson Parish jail.

Also, during the investigation, a second subject with alleged involvement was developed. The second subject, Israel Freeman, a 29 year old New Orleans resident, is being sought in connection to the Luling robbery.
