SHERIFF CHAMPAGNE PROMOTES TWO EMPLOYEES TO CAPTAIN

Sheriff Champagne is pleased to announce that he has promoted two employees to the rank of Captain.

Captain George Breedy – Captain Breedy's law enforcement career spans over 32 years. In 1983, Captain Breedy joined the Harahan Police Department where he graduated first in his class at the basic training academy. There he served as a Patrol Deputy for approximately 5 years. In 1988, Captain Breedy joined the St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office as a Patrol Deputy. In 1990 Breedy was promoted to Detective in the Special Investigations Division where he worked narcotics and vice cases. In 1991, Breedy was promoted to a Sergeant over the Special Investigation Division where he remained for approximately four years. In 1995, Breedy was transferred to the Criminal Investigations Bureau. One year later, Breedy was promoted to Lieutenant and detailed to the DEA as a task force officer, where he remained for over 18 years. During that time Captain Breedy worked drug cases on a local, national, and international level.

Breedy was promoted to his current rank of Captain in October of 2015. Captain Breedy is assigned to the Executive Department as the assistant to Sheriff Champagne and Chief Cardella.

Captain Breedy resides in Destrehan with his wife of 28 years.

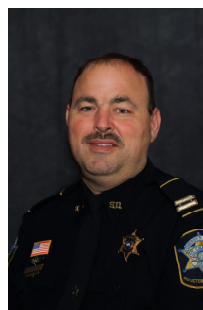
Captain Drauzin Kinler- Captain Kinler began his career in law enforcement in November of 1988 with the Orleans Parish Criminal Sheriff's Office. In September of 1989, Captain Kinler began his career with the St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office. Since that time Kinler has worked in Corrections, Transportation Division, and Patrol Division. Captain Kinler served 24 of his years of his career in the Patrol division rising through the ranks of Lieutenant and served as watch commander until October of 2014. In October of 2014, Kinler was assigned Director of the Information Technology Division where he now serves as a Captain.

Kinler, along with his IT duties also serves as a Certified Police Motorcycle Instructor and certified Motorcycle mechanic for the Sheriff's Office.
