On September 28, 2019 deputies received a complaint of a suspicious vehicle in Killona, LA.

During the investigation, deputies learned that at approximately 5:00 p.m., a dark green car, possibly a Honda, occupied by a dark skinned male, possibly Hispanic, stopped and the driver offered two male juveniles candy from the vehicle. The occupant informed the juveniles to enter the vehicle so they could retrieve the candy. When the two juveniles refused to enter, the vehicle fled the area.

Sheriff Champagne would like the public to be aware of this incident. The Sheriff's Office has launched an investigation, but parents should still speak with their children about the importance of never getting into a car with strangers, never accepting candy from strangers, and always call 911 or notify a trusted adult whenever a child feels uncomfortable around a stranger.
