



Destrehan vs. Hahnville High School Football Game Friday, November 8, 2019

On Friday, November 8th, the Hahnville Tigers will visit the Destrehan Fighting Wildcats for the 2019 Battle on the River. Kickoff is set for 7:00 PM. Due to limited parking at Destrehan High, an alternate parking site has been designated at the Jerusalem Shriner's Temple on Ormond Blvd. Buses will begin transporting fans from the Jerusalem Temple to Wildcat Stadium beginning at 5:15 PM. The buses will run every ½ hour until 7:00 PM. Return trips will begin with eight (8) minutes left in the game. Announcements will be made towards the end of the game informing fans of the bus departure location. We encourage you to use the shuttle service and to carpool due to limited parking availability.

In preparation for the large crowds that are expected, there will be some temporary parking and traffic flow restrictions to assist with congestion and to make sure emergency vehicles have access to all residences in the area of Destrehan High School. These restrictions are being implemented by the St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office, Public Works, and the School Board. Again, the restrictions are only temporary and after the crowds leave, all parking and traffic flows will revert to normal.

- Beginning Friday morning, no one will be allowed to park any portion of a vehicle
- in the street on Schexnaydre Lane or Thomas Colby Drive. All vehicles in violation are subject to being ticketed and towed.

- At 2:30 PM on the day of the game, Schexnaydre Lane at Wildcat Lane will
- become a one-way roadway with all traffic having to travel northbound towards Thomas Colby Drive.

- At 2:30 PM, Thomas Colby Drive will also become a one-way roadway with all traffic having to travel eastbound towards Ormond Boulevard only. Residents of
- Thomas Colby Drive should plan to reach their homes via Schexnaydre Lane after 2:30 PM.

- At 2:30 PM, Wildcat Lane will be closed at Ormond Boulevard.
- All restrictions will remain in effect until after the game is over.
