# News Release

November 18, 2014

The St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office Special Investigations Division received information regarding a parcel package which was intercepted at the John F. Kennedy International Airport mail branch during an enforcement examination of express mail from China. The parcel was examined and found to contain approximately 1,042 grams of a brown crystal rock-like substance secreted within a foil pouch. Subsequent field tests were conducted on the discovered rock-like substance which showed positive for the presence of suspected Methylenedioxypropylone (mdpv-bath salts) and is often distributed in the form of the designer drug commonly known as "Molly". The street value on the package has an estimated street value of \$90,000.

The package was addressed to 230 Meadows Drive in Destrehan, Louisiana.

On Friday, November 14th of 2014, Investigators with the Special Investigations Division, with the assistance of United States Postal Service and Department of Homeland Security conducted a controlled delivery of the parcel package to 230 Meadows Drive in Destrehan. Lojoan M. Fiffie signed for the package. A search warrant was then executed at Fiffie's residence. During the search officers located: the box containing the 1,042 grams of bath salts, Marijuana, Drug Paraphernalia, Phenobarbital, Tramadol, and Valium. An infant was also located inside of the residence.

Fiffie was arrested and booked accordingly. She was released on November 17, 2014 by posting a \$5,030 cash bond.
