Sheriff Greg Champagne reports deputies conducted a suspicious vehicle stop with a vehicle that was located at the West Bank Bridge Park after hours of operation. During the investigation it was learned that Tregre and a 12 year old female were occupying the vehicle. A detective arrived and through a continued investigation it was learned that Tregre allegedly had sexual encounters with the 12 year old female on more than one occasion since the beginning of April, 2018. Tregre was an acquaintance of the victim's family. Tregre was arrested accordingly.
