CHGS: Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon, Firearm Free Zone

Sheriff Greg Champagne reports Jerrell Alexander was arrested for a warrant issued in relation to the above mentioned charges.

The warrant claims that on December 15, 2018, deputies responded to IHOP in Boutte after learning that two subjects with possible involvement to a homicide in Lafourche Parish were at the restaurant. Deputies arrived and apprehended Jerrell Alexander and his brother Kerry Alexander.

During the investigation it was believed that Jerrell Alexander and Kerry Alexander discarded a backpack containing a firearm in the dumpster located behind IHOP, prior to being apprehended by deputies. Due to the dumpster being located less than 1,000 feet from a school campus, the area is deemed a "Firearm Free Zone".

Both subjects were initially arrested and transferred to Lafourche Parish due to pending charges related to the homicide investigation. Warrants were issued in St. Charles Parish for both subjects in relation to Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon and Possessing a Firearm in a Firearm Free Zone.

Kerry Alexander is currently incarcerated in the Lafourche Parish Correctional Complex and has not yet transferred to St. Charles Parish to answer to his criminal charges here.
