The St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office is seeking the public's assistance in locating a missing 17-year-old female.

On Monday, April 11th 2022, Da'Janae Chambers was seen leaving for school at 6:00 am by her mother. When Da'Janae did not return home from school and after checking for her at various relatives house, her mother contacted the Sheriff's Office and reported her as a runaway.

Through investigation, detectives learned that Da'Janae did not attend school on the 11th and was observed driving around Baton Rouge with an unknown black male. Da'Janae is believed to still be in the Baton Rouge area.

Da'Janae Chambers is described as a black female with black hair and brown eyes. She is approximately 5'2" tall, weighing approximately 150 lbs.
