<b>Incident:</b>	Criminal mischief – vehicle “egged”

<b>Sheriff Greg Champagne reports the complainant received a phone call about a suspicious purchase on her Amazon account. She spoke with a male subject claiming to be a DEA Agent and advised her that a vehicle registered to her was located in Texas with blood all over it and drugs inside. The subject told her there was a warrant for her arrest. The complainant hung up and she received a call showing the number for the St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office on caller id. A subject claiming to be Lieutenant Jay Smith told her she had a warrant for her arrest and needed to turn herself in. The complainant contacted the Sheriff's Office to verify the phone calls were scams.</b>

There were several juveniles in the complainant's vehicle, and they believe the Nissan Altima was occupied by students from another high school.</b>
