ST. CHARLES PARISH SHERIFF'S OFFICE DETECTIVES SEEK ASSISTANCE REGARDING SHOOTING IN THE 1000 BLOCK OF PAUL FREDRICK STREET IN LULING, LOUISIANA

Luling, Louisiana November 2, 2022:

The St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office is seeking the public's assistance for information on a shooting that occurred Tuesday, November 1, 2022, around 10:45 P.M. in the 1000 block of Paul Fredrick Street in Luling.

Deputies were dispatched to the area around 10:45 P.M. based on the report of gunfire.

When deputies arrived at the location, they located a juvenile male subject with gunshot wounds. Deputies immediately began rendering aid and he was transported to a local area hospital. The juvenile has been released from the hospital.

A stolen vehicle from a nearby parish was located abandoned in the area with damage from gunfire.

Deputies were dispatched to a local area hospital on the report of a second male subject with gunshot wounds at approximately 11:15 P.M. He is also listed in stable condition.

These two shootings are believed to be related.

This is an ongoing active investigation.

We are urging anyone with any information including citizens in the area with home surveillance or Ring camera systems to review their video footage and to contact Detective Joshua DeRoche with the St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office at jderoche@stcharlessheriff.org, 911, or (985) 783-1135. Citizens may also contact CRIMESTOPPERS at 1-877-903-STOP. You do not have to give your name nor testify and could receive up to a \$2,500 reward for information leading to an arrest.
