DETECTIVES SEEK ASSISTANCE IN GUNFIRE THAT DAMAGED A RESIDENCE ON CARRIAGE LANE IN DESTREHAN

Destrehan, Louisiana: December 14, 2022

Deputies with the St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office responded to the report of gunfire in the 50 block of Carriage Lane in Destrehan, LA just after 2 A.M. today, December 14, 2022. The caller advised she was awoken from sleep by a loud noise but was unsure what it was. She reported hearing one gunshot.

Responding deputies located multiple casings near the residence. The rear sliding glass door of the residence was shattered along with three bullet holes in the glass. Several bullet holes were located in the rear fence and trash can.

This is an ongoing active investigation.
